<u>Word</u>	<u>Part of Speech</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Waged	Verb	to engage in war or in a serious fight to achieve an end
Disunionists	Noun	Supporters of the secession movement leading up to the American Civil War
Sectional	Adjective	Involving different groups or sections of a society or region. Divided groups
Associate Justice	Noun	A member of the Georgia Supreme Court. Not the Chief Justice.
Draft	Verb	to sketch or write a first version of a picture, document, or plan
Ordinance	Noun	a law or rule made by an authority such as a city government
Secession	Noun	the withdrawal from the Union of 11 Southern States in 1860-1861 that led to the formation of the Confederacy and the beginning of the Civil War
Old Dominion	Noun	Nickname for the state of Virginia
Rebel	Noun	a soldier who belongs to a force seeking to overthrow a government or ruling power
