Word	Part of Speech	Definition
Sanitation	Noun	collection and disposal of sewage and garbage
Broadened	Verb	to enlarge the range or magnitude of something, or become wider in range or magnitude
Approach	Verb	to enlarge the range or magnitude of something, or become wider in range or magnitude
Poverty	Noun	the state of not having enough money to take care of basic needs such as food, clothing, and housing
Sniper	Noun	somebody who shoots people from a hidden position
Erupted	Verb	to burst out suddenly or violently
Demonstrations	Noun	a public show as a group for or against an issue, cause, or person
Convicted	Verb	to declare somebody guilty of a crime in a court of law
Recanted	Verb	To take back something you said
Native	Adjective	A person born or coming from a particular place
