Word	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Troubleshooter	Noun	A person whose job is to solve problems
Election	Noun	an organized event at which somebody is chosen by vote for something, especially a public office
City Council	Noun	a group of elected officials responsible for the government of a city or other municipality
Ambassador	Noun	a diplomatic official of the highest rank sent by one country as its long-term representative to another
Constituency	Noun	the voters or residents in a particular electoral district
Incumbent	Noun	somebody currently holding an official post, especially in a church or political organization
Appointed	Verb	To give someone a position
Terrorist	Noun	somebody who uses violence, especially bombing, kidnapping, and assassination, to intimidate others, often for political purposes
