Word	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Disasters	Noun	an event that causes serious loss, destruction, hardship, unhappiness, or death
Devastating	Adjective	causing severe or widespread damage
Debris	Noun	pieces of something that has been destroyed or broken into pieces
Funnel	Noun	Cone-shaped cloud of condensed water droplets, usually with a rotating column of wind
Toured	Noun	a short trip or visit for the purpose of viewing or inspecting something
Rededicate	Verb	To again devote someone or something to a specific task or purpose
