<u>Word</u>	<u>Part of Speech</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Franciscan Monks	Noun	a member of an order of friars and nuns, founded by St. Francis of Assisi, that now has three separate branches and is largely devoted to missionary and charitable work.
Marketing	Noun	the business activity of presenting products or services in such a way as to make them desirable
Production	Noun	the process of manufacturing or growing a product for sale
Decades	Noun	A period of ten years
Refrigerated	Adjective	describes a vehicle or container designed to keep its contents or cargo at a low temperature in order to preserve them
Bushels	Noun	a unit of measure in the U.S. Customary system used for measuring dry goods, equal to 1/64 U.S. pints (35.24 liters)
Popular Culture	Noun	The combination of ideas, perspectives, attitudes that are known or liked by a majority of people in a given culture.
