Word	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Manufacturing	Verb	to make something into a finished product using raw materials, especially on a large industrial scale
Surrender	Verb	to tell an opponent that he or she has won so that fighting can stop
Secession	Noun	the withdrawal from the Union of 11 Southern States in 1860-1861 that led to the formation of the Confederacy and the beginning of the Civil War
Confederacy	Noun	Confederate States of America. the confederation of the 11 southern states that seceded from the United States in 1861,
Boasted	Verb	To brag. To overstate possessions or accomplishments
Primacy	Noun	the state of being the first or most important part or aspect of something
Textile	Fabric	cloth or fabric that is woven, knitted, or otherwise manufactured
