Word	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Architecture	Noun	the art and science of designing and constructing buildings
Beaux-Arts Classicism	Noun	A style of architecture taught and produced out of the French Royale Academy of Architecture. More traditional and based on centuries of architecture in Europe.
Lobbied	Verb	to attempt to persuade a political representative or influential person to support or oppose a particular cause
Licensed	Noun	a printed document that gives official permission to a person or group to own something or do something
Federal Reserve	Noun	The Federal Reserve is the central bank of the United States with 12 area branches.
