<u>Word</u>	<u>Part of Speech</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Lie in State	Verb	a term used to describe the tradition in which a coffin is placed on view to allow the public at large to pay their respects to the deceased.
Rotunda	Noun	the central rotunda of the United States Capitol in Washington, D.C.. Located below the Capitol dome
Conservatory	Noun	an institution or school where students are taught one of the arts, most commonly music or drama, to a professional standard
Integral	Adjective	Necessary, essential
Activism	Noun	action taken in pursuing a political or social result
Assassinated	Verb	to kill somebody, especially a political leader or other public figure, by a sudden violent attack
Advocated	Verb	to support or speak in favor of something
Dignity	Noun	Self-respect - the condition of being worthy of respect, esteem, or honor
