<u>Word</u>	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Warrior	Noun	Somebody experienced in warfare, someone who fights in war
Fluent	Adjective	Able to easily speak a language
Prominent	Adjective	Well-known, distinguished. An important person
Loyalty	Noun	A feeling of duty, connection or devotion to somebody or something
Alienated	Adjective	Cut-off, isolated, excluded, left out of a society or culture
Consent	Noun	Permission
Negotiated	Verb	to attempt to come to an agreement on something through discussion and compromise
Ceded	Verb	To give up something usually land
Controversial	Adjective	Causing argument, debate and strong opinion
