| Word | Part of Speech | <u>Definition</u> |
|-------------|----------------|---|
| Confederate | Noun | a supporter or soldier of the Confederate States of America during the Civil War |
| Cornerstone | Noun | The first stone laid of a new building or structure |
| Dedicate | Verb | to set something aside for a particular purpose |
| Enthusiasm | Noun | Exciting interest, passionate interest in or eagerness to do something |
| Emergence | Verb | To appear out of or from somewhere |
| Affirmation | Noun | Agreeing that something is true, making a positive statement that something is true |
| Triumphant | Adjective | Successful, victorious, impressive |
