<u>Word</u>	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Confederacy	Noun	the confederation of the 11 southern states that seceded from the United States in 1861, an act that started the Civil War. Alabama, Arkansas, Florida, Georgia, Louisiana, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, and Virginia were the states that seceded.
Hub	Noun	a place that is a center of activity or interest
Morale	Noun	the general level of confidence or optimism felt by a person or group of people, especially as it affects discipline and motivation
Notoriously	Adjective	well known for some undesirable feature, quality, or act
Unaggressive	Adjective	Not bold or quick to forceful action
Opponent	Noun	somebody who plays, fights, or competes against you in a contest or battle
Tone	Noun	the general quality or character of something as an indicator of the attitude or view of the person who produced it
Flanked	Verb	to be on or at the side of something or somebody
Ensured	Verb	to make sure that something will happen or be available
