| Word | Part of Speech | <u>Definition</u> |
|----------------|----------------|---|
| Attorney | Noun | Lawyer, a qualified lawyer, especially one who represents clients in court proceedings |
| Firm | Noun | a group formed by one or more lawyers to practice of law. |
| Janitorial | Noun | somebody whose job is to look after the cleaning and maintenance of a building, especially a school or an apartment building. |
| Preaching | Verb | to give a talk on a religious or moral subject, especially in church |
| Pastored | Verb | to act as pastor for a church or congregation |
| Congressman | Noun | Member of the U.S. Congress |
| Regiment | Noun | a permanent military unit usually consisting of two or three battalions of ground troops divided into smaller companies or troops under the command of a colonel |
| Fierce | Adjective | deeply and intensely felt and often aggressively expressed |
| Opposition | Noun | a disapproving attitude toward something and a wish to prevent it, or action taken to show disapproval of and prevent something |
| Reconstruction | Noun | the period of U.S. history from 1865 through 1877, during which the states that had seceded during the Civil War were reorganized under federal control and later restored to the Union |
| Postmaster | Noun | the person in charge of a post office or postal district |
