<u>Word</u>	<u>Part of Speech</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Attorney	Noun	Lawyer, a qualified lawyer, especially one who represents clients in court proceedings
Firm	Noun	a group formed by one or more lawyers to practice of law.
Janitorial	Noun	somebody whose job is to look after the cleaning and maintenance of a building, especially a school or an apartment building.
Preaching	Verb	to give a talk on a religious or moral subject, especially in church
Pastored	Verb	to act as pastor for a church or congregation
Congressman	Noun	Member of the U.S. Congress
Regiment	Noun	a permanent military unit usually consisting of two or three battalions of ground troops divided into smaller companies or troops under the command of a colonel
Fierce	Adjective	deeply and intensely felt and often aggressively expressed
Opposition	Noun	a disapproving attitude toward something and a wish to prevent it, or action taken to show disapproval of and prevent something
Reconstruction	Noun	the period of U.S. history from 1865 through 1877, during which the states that had seceded during the Civil War were reorganized under federal control and later restored to the Union
Postmaster	Noun	the person in charge of a post office or postal district
