

May 11, 1803: Georgia's First Land Lottery Vocabulary

<u>Word</u>	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Lottery	Noun	A game or situation where the outcome depends on chance. As a game the lottery works by selling tickets and a draw is held to select the winners
Bargain	Adjective	Cheap, less than the usual price
Migrating	Verb	To move from place to place often to seek work or other economic opportunities
Revolution	Noun	Overthrow of government – in this case referencing the American Revolution
Treaty	Noun	An agreement or formal contract between two countries or political entities
Distributed	Adjective	Given out in pieces
Corrupt	Adjective	Immoral or dishonest – using a position of power for personal gain
Speculator	Noun	Somebody who makes risky deals for profit
Residence	Noun	Living somewhere
Aristocratic	Adjective	A word used to describe established wealthy families with grand or elegant lifestyle
