| <u>Word</u> | <u>Part of Speech</u> | <u>Definition</u> |
|----------------|-----------------------|--|
| Independent | Adjective | in politics, free from the authority, control, or domination of somebody or something else, especially not controlled by another state or organization and able to self-govern |
| Inauguration | Noun | the formal act of placing somebody in an official position, especially the President of the United States, or a ceremony held for this purpose |
| Conquering | Verb | Victory in war |
| Inspected | Verb | to examine or review something officially |
| Fortifications | Noun | a structure built in order to strengthen a place's defenses, e.g. a wall, ditch, or rampart |
| Allegiance | Noun | Commitment or loyalty to a ruler or state |
