They had higher levels of comfort and functionality than earlier sailing ships. goods or cargo carried by a commercial means of transportation |
| Converted      | Verb                  | to change the function or use of something, or be able to change in function or use  |
| Transatlantic  | Adjective             | Crossing the Atlantic ocean  |
| Hybrid         | Noun                  | A form of transportation that uses two different types of power  |
| Namesake       | Noun                  | somebody or something with the same name as somebody or something else   |
| Experimental   | Adjective             | using ideas, methods, or materials that have not been tried before   |
| Freight        | Noun                  | goods or cargo carried by a commercial means of transportation   |
