Word	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Founder	Noun	Somebody who starts an institution, business, organization or in this case colony
Buffer	Noun	A protection against harm
Fated	Adjective	Inevitable, predetermined to have a certain outcome
Focal Point	Noun	Center of attention
Hostilities	Noun	Open military attacks
Company of Foot	Noun	A group of trained soldiers who fight on foot
Allies	Noun	a person, group, or state that is joined in an association with another or others for a common purpose
Retaliated	Verb	Make an attack or assault in return for a similar attack.
Decisively	Adjective	settling or ending something such as a debate, controversy, or contest
Empires	Noun	a group of nations, territories, or peoples ruled by a single authority, especially an emperor or empress
