Empress	Noun	A woman who rules an empire
Soul	Noun	a popular music genre that originated in the United States in the 1950s and early 1960s, combining elements of African American gospel music and rhythm and blues.
Amateur	Noun	somebody with limited skill in, or knowledge of, an activity
Forerunner	Noun	an earlier person or thing that had a role or function similar to somebody or something coming later
Impromptu	Adjective	Not prepared or planned in advance
Decade	Noun	A period of ten years
R&B	Noun	Rhythm and blues, often abbreviated to <i>R&B</i> , is a genre of popular African American music that originated in the 1940s
