Word	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Excelled	Verb	to be outstanding or have a particular talent in something
Photo Finish	Noun	the end of a race in which two or more contestants are so close that the result must be determined from a photograph taken as they cross the finish line
Alderman	Noun	a man who is a member of the legislating body of some towns or cities in the United States and Canada
Caucus	Noun	a group of people, often within a larger group such as a legislative assembly, who unite to promote a particular policy or particular interests
Inducted	Verb	To formally put someone in a position or office. Some government jobs are appointed meaning they are not elected but chosen
