Word	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Throne	Noun	the power, rank, and privileges of a monarch
Ascended	Verb	to succeed to an important position, especially as a monarch
Reign	Noun	the period of time during which somebody, especially a king or queen, rules a nation
Misery	Noun	Great unhappiness
Madness	Noun	A term for having a psychiatric disorder or mental illness
Empire	Noun	a group of nations, territories, or peoples ruled by a single authority, especially an emperor or empress
Disastrous	Adjective	Completely unsuccessful, having serious damaging results
Policies	Noun	Course of actions adopted by a person, group, or government
Rebellion	Noun	an organized attempt to overthrow a government or other authority by the use of violence
Ultimately	Adverb	Eventually, the result of a process or event.
