Vocabulary

<u>Word</u>	<u>Part of Speech</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Moonshiner	Noun	A person who makes and sells moonshine (illegally made alcohol)
Conventions	Noun	a gathering of people who have a common interest or profession
Ballad	Noun	a song or poem, especially a traditional one or one in a traditional style, telling a story in a number of short regular stanzas, often with a refrain
Scout	Noun	somebody whose job is to search for people who have exceptional abilities in some field such as entertainment or sports and recruit them for professional work
