Word	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Confederate	Adjective	related to the Confederate States of America during the Civil War
Pen Name	Noun	A false name used by a writer instead of his or her real name
Humorous	Adjective	Funny – intended to be amusing, witty, or able to make people laugh
Dialect	Noun	Regional variety of language with differences in vocabulary, grammar, and pronunciation
Literary Comedians	Noun	Writing that is made to amuse, entertain or make people laugh
Syndicated	Verb	to sell something such as an article or a comic strip for publication in multiple newspapers or magazines at the same time
Philosopher	Noun	a thinker who deeply and seriously considers human affairs and life in general
Securing	Verb	To guarantee something, to ensure that something will happen
