Word	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Chain	Noun	a number of stores, hotels, restaurants, or other businesses that are owned by the same company and offer similar goods or services but are found in different locations
Warehouses	Noun	a large store, especially one where goods are sold wholesale
Competitor	Noun	an opponent, especially in a commercial market
Enlisted	Verb	to gain the cooperation or support of somebody or something, or become actively involved in an effort
Merchandiser	Noun	goods bought and sold for profit
Cavernous	Adjective	like or suggestive of a cavern, especially in being large, dark, deep, and hollow
Revolutionized	Verb	To change something radically – to cause a radical change in something such as a method or approach
