Word	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Prohibition	Noun	in the United States, the period between 1919 and 1933 during which the manufacture, sale, and transportation of alcoholic beverages was forbidden by the 18th Amendment
Suffragist	Noun	a supporter of the extension of the right to vote to a particular group, especially to women, or to all people above a particular age
Temperance	Noun	total abstinence from alcoholic drink
Amendment	Noun	an addition or alteration to a motion, bill, or constitution
