<u>Word</u>	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Entrepreneur	Noun	somebody who starts or provides the money to start new commercial companies and businesses
Cotton Factor	Noun	The merchant who sold the cotton for the planters
Unrivaled	Adjective	Has no equal or rival – set apart
Vertical Integration	Noun	the bringing together of companies that are in the chain of companies handling a single item from raw material production to retail sale.
Textile Mills	Noun	The facility where cotton was turned into thread, woven into cloth and dyed
Philanthropy	Noun	a desire to improve the material, social, and spiritual welfare of humanity, especially through charitable activities
