Word	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Parliamentary Committee	Noun	A group of legislatures that have a specific duty such as approving charters to start colonies.
Reform	Noun	the reorganization and improvement of something such as a political institution or system that is considered to be faulty, ineffective, or unjust
Trustees	Noun	A country or group of people responsible for administering and supervising a territory
Haven	Noun	A sheltered safe place
Destitute	Adjective	lacking all money, resources, and possessions necessary to take care of yourself and family
Charter	Noun	a formal written statement describing the rights and responsibilities of a state and its citizens
Stability	Noun	The state of being steady, not changing, safe
Repelling	Verb	To keep something or someone away
Ambassador	Noun	a diplomatic official of the highest rank sent by one country as its long-term representative to another
