<u>Word</u>	<u>Part of Speech</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Global	Adjective	Worldwide – involving countries throughout the world
Clash	Verb	a short fierce encounter, verbal or physical, with another person or group
Empires	Noun	a group of nations, territories, or peoples ruled by a single authority, especially an emperor or empress
Skirmish	Noun	A brief fight between two armed groups -- an incident where fighting breaks out briefly between two small groups, sometimes as part of a larger battle
Pirateering	Verb	Piracy - robbery committed or attempted on the high seas
Retaliated	Verb	to deliberately harm somebody in response or revenge for a harm he or she has done
Invasion	Verb	Attempt to conquer
Repelled	Verb	To resist or keep off an attack or force back an invasion
Casualties	Noun	a member of the armed forces who is killed or injured during combat
