Word	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Valedictorian	Noun	a student in a graduating class who is highest in academic ranking and is usually required to give a valedictory address at the graduation ceremony
Recruited	Verb	to enroll somebody as a worker or member, or to take on people as workers or members
Segregation	Noun	the practice of keeping ethnic, racial, religious, or gender groups separate, especially by enforcing the use of separate schools, transportation, housing, and other facilities, and usually discriminating against a minority group
Cum Laude	Adjective	With academic honors
Scholarship	Noun	a sum of money awarded to a student to help with living expenses, study, or travel
Trailblazer	Noun	a pioneer or innovator somebody who makes a new path
