

July 11, 1733: First Jewish Settlers in Georgia Vocabulary

Word	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Immigrants	Noun	a newcomer to a country who has settled there
Migrants	Noun	somebody who moves from one place to another, often for employment or economic improvement
Synagogue	Noun	the place of worship and communal center of a Jewish congregation
Sephardic Jews	Noun	a Jew of Spanish or Portuguese origin, or one who is not of German or eastern European descent Ashkenazi.
Heritage	Noun	a country's or area's history
Torah	Noun	Five books of moses the Jewish Pentateuch, or a parchment scroll on which the Pentateuch is written for use in services in synagogues
Congregation	Noun	a group of people who have gathered for a religious service
