 Vocabulary

<u>Word</u>	<u>Part of Speech</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Honorable	Adjective	used as a title of respect before somebody's name to indicate entitlement to respect because of an official position held, or used to address a parliamentary colleague
Profession	Noun	An occupation (job) that requires education or training
Consecutive	Adjective	Following one after the other without a break
National security	Noun	the protection of a nation from attack or other danger by maintaining adequate armed forces and guarding state secrets
Shrewd	Adjective	showing or possessing intelligence, insight, and sound judgment, especially in business or politics
Pentagon	Noun	the U.S. Department of Defense, or the five-sided main building that houses it
