Prominent	Adjective	distinguished, eminent, or well-known
Daring	Adjective	showing a courageous or reckless disregard for danger
Secessionist	Noun	A person supporting the policy of the southern states withdrawing from the Union to establish the Confederacy
Provisional Confederate Congress	Noun	for a time the legislative branch of the Confederate States of America,
Advocated	Verb	to support or speak in favor of something
