<u>Word</u>	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Namesake	Noun	somebody or something with the same name as somebody or something else
Prestigious	Adjective	Significant, important, highly respected
Aptitude	Noun	a natural tendency to do something well, especially one that can be further developed
Finance	Noun	the business or art of managing the monetary resources of an organization, country, or person
Investment firm	Noun	a financial institution that sells shares to individuals and invests in securities issued by other companies.
Benefactors	Noun	somebody who aids a cause, institution, or person, especially with a gift of money
Philanthropist	Noun	a desire to improve the material, social, and spiritual welfare of humanity, especially through charitable activities
