<u>Word</u>	Part of Speech	Definition
Accused	Verb	Charged with committing a crime
Acknowledge	Verb	Admit to something
Despite	Preposition	In spite of, notwithstanding, without being affected by
Publicized	Verb	To make something generally known to people
Sensationalized	Verb	Placing a lot of emphasis on shocking and dramatic parts of a story or event
Contradicted	Verb	To disagree with – to argue against
Affidavits	Noun	a written sworn statement of fact voluntarily made by someone usually for court proceedings
Convicted	Verb	to declare somebody guilty of a crime in a court of law
