Othello	Noun	Main character in the play Othello: he play's protagonist and hero. A Christian Moor and general of the armies of Venice, Othello is an eloquent and physically powerful figure, respected by all those around him. In spite of his elevated status, he is nevertheless easy prey to insecurities because of his age, his life as a soldier, and his race. He possesses a "free and open nature," which his ensign lago uses to twist his love for his wife, Desdemona, into a powerful and destructive jealousy
Soap Opera	Noun	a serial on television or radio that deals with the lives of a group of characters, especially in a melodramatic or sentimental way
Feature Film Debut	Noun	First time to appear in a major feature film
Apocalypse	Noun	the destruction or devastation of something, or an instance of this
Playwright	Noun	A person who writes plays
Screenwriter	Noun	the writer of a script that is intended to be filmed
