 Vocabulary

<u>Word</u>	<u>Part of Speech</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Declaration	Noun	a proclamation or affirmative announcement.
Independence	noun	freedom from the control and support of others.
Continental Congress	Noun	the assembly of the two legislative congresses which convened during and after the American Revolution.
Foreign-born	Adjective	born in a country other than that in which one lives
Deist	Noun	one who believes in God based on natural reason, not on supernatural revelation.
Republic	Noun	a form of government in which the citizens have the overall power by way of voting and that power is exercised by representatives elected directly or indirectly by them.
