Word	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Psychological	Adjective	Relating to the human mind or mental processes
Foundation	Noun	the basis or groundwork of anything.
Posthumous	Adjective	After death
Pulitzer Prize	Noun	a prize awarded annually for excellence in American journalism, literature, or music
Designated	Verb	marked, noted, or pointed out for an office or position.
Poet Laureate	Noun	a poet recognized and acclaimed by his or her country and/or officially appointed to write poems for special occasions.
