Word	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Critical	Adjective	extremely important, essential, necessary
Pacifist	Noun	Someone who believes that violence, war, and the taking of lives are unacceptable ways of resolving disputes
Quaker	Noun	a member of the Society of Friends, a Christian denomination founded in England in the 17th century that rejects formal sacraments, ministry, and creed, and is committed to pacifism. At meetings members are encouraged to speak when they feel moved to do so.
Militia	Noun	an organization of citizens with limited military training who are available for emergency service or defense.
Battered	Adjective	Worn down, damaged by repeated attack
Undermanned	Adjective	Not supplied with enough soldiers
