<u>Word</u>	<u>Part of Speech</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Plotting	Verb	Making secret plans, especially to do with something illegal or damaging to another group
Opposition	Noun	a disapproving attitude toward something and a wish to prevent it, or action taken to show disapproval of and prevent something
Parliament	Noun	the legislature of Great Britain.
Revoked	Verb	To formally cancel something or make something void
Intolerable Acts	Noun	The name used to describe a series of laws passed by the British Parliament in 1774 relating to Britain's colonies in North America. Some of these acts were a result of the Boston Tea Party
Contrary	Adjective	Opposite in direction or position.
Asserted	Verb	To state with assurance, confidence, or force; state strongly or positively; affirm.
Tentative	Adjective	said or done in a slow, hesitant, and careful way that reveals a lack of confidence
