<u>Word</u>	<u>Part of Speech</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Toppled	Verb	To make something fall forward or tip over
Anti-Confederate	Adjective	Opposed to the Confederate States of America
Activist	Noun	Someone who is actively and sometimes aggressively in support of a certain cause
Vibrant	Adjective	Energetic, full of loveliness or energy
Memorial	Noun	something that is intended to remind people of somebody who has died or an event in which people died, e.g. a statue, speech, or ceremony
Squatty	Adjective	short and thickset
Bulging	Verb	To expand or swell – to overfill
Lampooned	Verb	A sarcastic attack used to ridicule something
Exhumed	Verb	To dig up someone or something
Collided	Verb	To crash into something
