Word	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Progress	Noun	Positive development. Development, usually of a gradual kind, toward achieving a goal or reaching a higher standard
Exposition	Noun	a large exhibition, e.g. of industrial achievements, sometimes international in scope
Mired	Verb	To involve or entangle; to trap.
Prosperity	Noun	A successful, flourishing, or thriving condition
Delegation	Noun	a group of people chosen to represent a political unit such as a state
Offensive	Adjective	Upsetting, insulting, or irritating.
Tout	Verb	to describe or advertise boastfully; publicize or promote; praise highly
