Word	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Conspiring	Verb	To agree together, especially secretly, to do something wrong, evil, or illegal.
Insurrection	Noun	an act of revolt, rebellion, or resistance against civil authority or an established government.
Plot	Noun	a secret plan or scheme to accomplish some purpose, especially an unlawful purpose
Conspirators	Noun	a member of a group of people planning or agreeing in secret to commit an illegal or subversive act
Undermine	Verb	to weaken something by removing or wearing away material from its base or from beneath it
Seized	Verb	to take a hold of an object quickly and firmly
Stark	Adjective	forbidding in its bareness and lack of any ornament, relieving feature, or pleasant prospect
Complex	Adjective	difficult to analyze, understand, or solve
