<u>Word</u>	<u>Part of Speech</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Fiercely	Adjective	furiously eager or intense
Resisted	Verb	To refuse to give in to something, to oppose and stand firm against somebody or something
Desegregating	Verb	To eliminate racial segregation
Contested	Verb	To challenge or question something
Terrain	Noun	Ground or a piece of land seen in terms of its surface features or general physical character, especially for crossing it or using it for military purposes
Recreational	Verb	Of or pertaining to a resource allowing relaxation and enjoyment; a pastime or agreeable exercise.
Custom	Noun	something that people always do or always do in a particular way by tradition
Facilities	Noun	something designed or created to provide a service or fulfill a need
Hastily	Adjective	Done in a hurry
