<u>Word</u>	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Cartoonist	Noun	A person who creates humorous drawings for a newspaper or magazine.
Animator	Noun	A person who draws representations of animals that appear to move as real ones do.
Dialect	Noun	A regional variety of a language, with differences in vocabulary, grammar, and pronunciation
Stereotypes	Noun	A generalization, usually exaggerated or oversimplified and often offensive, that is used to describe or distinguish a group
Satiric	Adjective	Containing satire the use of wit, especially irony, sarcasm, and ridicule, to criticize faults
Anti-Communist	Adjective	a person who does not support and is against those who support a system of social organization in which all economic and social activity is controlled by a totalitarian state dominated by a single and self-perpetuating political party.
Segregationist	Noun	one who favors, encourages, or practices, usually by force, separation or isolation of ethnic or religious groups from the general body of society
Feat	Noun	a noteworthy or extraordinary act or achievement
