| <u>Word</u> | <u>Part of Speech</u> | <u>Definition</u> |
|----------------|-----------------------|---|
| Cartoonist | Noun | A person who creates humorous drawings for a newspaper or magazine. |
| Animator | Noun | A person who draws representations of animals that appear to move as real ones do. |
| Dialect | Noun | A regional variety of a language, with differences in vocabulary, grammar, and pronunciation |
| Stereotypes | Noun | A generalization, usually exaggerated or oversimplified and often offensive, that is used to describe or distinguish a group |
| Satiric | Adjective | Containing satire --- the use of wit, especially irony, sarcasm, and ridicule, to criticize faults |
| Anti-Communist | Adjective | a person who does not support and is against those who support a system of social organization in which all economic and social activity is controlled by a totalitarian state dominated by a single and self-perpetuating political party. |
| Segregationist | Noun | one who favors, encourages, or practices, usually by force, separation or isolation of ethnic or religious groups from the general body of society |
| Feat | Noun | a noteworthy or extraordinary act or achievement |
