<u>Word</u>	<u>Part of Speech</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Destructive	Adjective	Causing or capable of causing destruction
Churning	Verb	To shake or agitate with violence or continued motion.
Surge	Noun	The rolling swell of the sea, especially after the passage of a large wave
Landfall	Noun	An arrival on or a sighting of land, especially after a long journey by sea
Barometric	Noun	An instrument measuring changes in atmospheric pressure, used in weather forecasting
Impact	Noun	The powerful or dramatic effect that something or somebody has
Devastating	Adjective	Desolated; destroyed; ravaged.
Terrifying	Adjective	Frightening, alarming, scary
