<u>Word</u>	<u>Part of Speech</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Consecutive	Adjective	Following one another in uninterrupted succession or order; marked by a logical sequence.
Scholarship	Noun	A sum of money or other aid granted to a student because of merit or need to pursue his or her studies.
Qualified	Verb	To complete the preliminary part of a competition successfully and earn the right to go on to the next stage
Feat	Noun	a remarkable act or achievement involving courage, skill, or strength
Inducted	Verb	to install somebody formally into a position or office
