Condemn	Verb	To express an unfavorable or adverse judgment on; to indicate strong disapproval of.

Compromise	Verb	To make a dishonorable or shameful concession or allowance.
Courage	Noun	The ability to face danger, difficulty, uncertainty, or pain without being overcome by fear or being deflected from a chosen course of action
Unsung	Adjective	Not given the praise or honor that is due
