Glossary

Successful: Adjective, having attained wealth, position, honors, or the like.

Formal: adjective, being in accordance with the usual requirements, customs, etc.; conventional

Elite: adjective, representing the most choice or select; best.

Invested: verb, to use, by purchase or expenditure, in something offering potential profitable returns, as interest, income, or appreciation in value.

Elegant: adjective, tastefully fine or luxurious in dress, style, design, etc...

Operated: verb: to run or work an establishment

Ambitious: adjective, having ambition, eagerly desirous of achieving or obtaining success, power, wealth, a specific goal, etc...

Enterprising: adjective, energetic in carrying out any undertaking: characterized by great imagination or initiative.
