#### **Glossary**

**Advocated:** noun to speak or write in favor of; support or urge by argument; recommend publicly.

**Artillery:** noun; troops or the branch of an army concerned with the use and service of mounted projectile-firing guns or missile launchers, mobile or stationary, light or heavy.

**Campaign:** noun; the competition by rival political candidates and organizations for public office.

**Confidant:** noun; a close friend or associate to whom secrets are confided or with whom private matters and problems are discussed.

**Crusading:** verb; to engage in any vigorous, aggressive movement for the defense or advancement of an idea or cause.

**Disenfranchising:** verb; to deprive a person or group of a right of citizenship, especially the right to vote.

**Indelible:** adjective; that cannot be eliminated, forgotten, or changed; incapable of being erased.

**Tensions:** noun; mental or emotional strain; intense and suppressed suspense, anxiety, or excitement.
