Glossary

Accreditation: noun; certification that a college has met all formal official requirements of academic excellence, curriculum, and facilities.

Affiliated: adjective; being in close formal or informal association; related.

Chartered: verb; to establish formally by outlining the conditions under which a corporation, colony, college or other corporate body is organized and defining its rights and privileges.

Donated: verb; to present as a gift, grant, or contribution.

Founded: verb; to set up or establish on a firm basis or for enduring existence.

Institution: noun; an organization, establishment, foundation, or society devoted to the promotion of a particular cause or program, especially one of educational or charitable character.

Mission: noun; a specific task or duty assigned to a person or group of people.

Seminary: noun; a school of secondary or higher education for young women.

Trustee: noun; a person appointed to administer the affairs of an institution or company.
